



MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF BARNES ROADS AND RIGHT OF WAY COMMITTEE
July 6, 2021

Meeting called to order at 6:32 pm, quorum established
Motion to approve minutes of 6/1/2021 passed (Martin/Holm), no changes

Township right-of-way policy

New guidelines for roads right-of-way have been adopted by the board which utilize ten foot mowable minimum.

RROW committee member applicant

Application from resident Chris Lane to serve as a member of RROW committee was reviewed and discussed briefly. Judy will follow up with Jeff and Chris to set up interviews.

Rabbit Hutch Road

Re-grading work has begun by township crew to improve this heavily damaged road surface and will eventually include placement of 3 culverts (@ \$464). Project now being worked on is 6,352 feet and will continue as allowed by funding, materials, and seasonal changes. There will be no discontinuance of the road.

Moen Road

Norvado cable placement, preference of residents, and location make discontinuance of this road, or even a portion of it, problematic. There is also concern for access by emergency vehicles.

Moore/Ellison intersection

Funding is available and plans underway to rebuild this intersection improving dangerous slopes and poor sightlines. Work will be done by township crew. Approach from east will be lowered by three feet with commensurate raise of west approach. Culvert will be relocated.

Timeline/Project Log

Brief review and update of Project Log. Lake Road/Windsor intersection has been put out for bids for resurfacing with CRS-2P polymer modified, cationic water-based emulsified asphalt. Recommend work on road and intersection be done simultaneously -- with Lake designated a four-rod road. Delete Mulligan Creek from Project Log.
