(b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations.

Motion made (Bohl/Porter) to go into Closed Session. Voice vote taken with no opposition. Motion carried

Motion made (Porter/Bohl) to return to Open Session for discussion and possible action from Closed Session. Voice vote taken with no opposition. Motion carried.

Motion made (Bohl/Porter) to offer Judy Bourassa the Clerk-Treasurer position. Roll call vote taken with Porter, Bohl, Webb, Emerson and Krob voting yes. Motion carried.

Motion made (Bohl/Porter) to adjourn the Special Board Meeting. Voice vote taken with all voting yes. Motion carried.
