MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING

Tuesday June 25, 2019 at 6:00PM At Barnes Town Hall

(UNAPPROVED)

At 06:10pm, Chairperson Chris Webb called the Special Town Board Meeting to order. Roll call was taken with Town Supervisors Sue Jansen and Seana Frint present, establishing a quorum. Donna Porter and Tom Emerson arrived at 6:12am. Fire Chief/Ambulance Director Tom Renz was also in attendance along with Trevor Provost of C & S Design & Engineering. Ian Johnson of Northwest Builders, Inc., Dave Cecil of Dave Cecil Builders, Inc. and Tony Butterfield of Butterfield, LLC were also present.

Motion made (Frint/Jansen) to approve the agenda. Voice vote taken, motion carried.

Trevor Provost opened the bids received for the Fire/Ambulance Hall project. Bids were received from Cedar Brook Construction, LLC, Dave Cecil Builders, Inc., Four Star Construction, Inc. and Northwest Builders, Inc. All bids included a 5% bid bond. Two addendums had been issued and the contractors verified they were received and reflected in their bids. The base bids were as follows:

Cedar Brook Construction, LLC: \$497,540

Dave Cecil Builders, Inc.: \$489,779 Four Star Construction, Inc.: \$682,476 Northwest Builders, Inc.: \$541,134

Trevor Provost announced that Dave Cecil Builders, Inc. was the low bid. Alternate Nos. 1, 2 and 3 were reviewed with Alternate No.1 being a deduction for the epoxy resinous flooring, No. 2 was a deduction for kitchen cabinets and No. 3 was a deduction for one unit heater. Proposals for the well, electricity and the POWTS were also discussed.

Motion made (Emerson/Frint) to approve the Nor Pines Plumbing bid of \$6,000 for the POWTS. Voice vote taken, motion carried.

Motion made (Emerson/Frint) to approve the Butterfield bid of \$22,679 for the well. Voice vote taken, motion carried.

Motion made (Porter/Frint) to approve the Dahlberg Light & Power bid of \$2,731 for power. Voice vote taken, motion carried.

Motion made (Jansen/Frint) to award the bid to Dave Cecil Builders, Inc. not to exceed \$489,779. Voice vote taken, motion carried.

Supervisor Emerson asked how much money is in the sinking fund for the building of the new fire and ambulance hall. Chairperson Webb reported that there is \$351,139.75 in the sinking fund.

Motion made (Porter/Frint) to adjourn. Voice vote taken, motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:49pm.
