(b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations.

Motion made (Porter/Emerson) to go into Closed Session. Roll call vote taken with all voting yes. Motion carried.

Motion made (Porter/Emerson) to return to Open Session. Roll call vote taken with all voting yes. Motion carried.

Motion made (Porter/Emerson) to adjourn the Special Town Board Meeting. Roll call vote taken with all voting yes. Motion carried.
