Also present: Linda Clark, Donna Porter, Sue Pagnucci, Marcia Wellnitz and Andy Teal -Invasive Species Specialist for Bayfield Co. (Tomahawk Lake has a history of Eurasian Milfoil.)

Discussions & Suggestions are as follows: A new sign at the turn-in of Tomahawk Park Rd., combining separate signs at the boat landing to one spot -such as a kiosk posting board- instead of the current three sighs, and adding a laminated park map with the parking area sign.

The young-child play area could have more equipment.

The original lake water level should be considered when improvements are made, but moveable items could go anywhere. Fire-pits--use caution (would have to be above the high water level) and also could contribute to possible lake pollution. Explore new pump at the well head- it was shut down when the actual pump was gone.

Consider- but not necessary - another bathroom on the hill where the ski trail begins.

Camping should not be an option it would be very expensive and a caretaker would be necessary.

Advertise the park more. "it's a great area".... No major changes were suggested
