The Town of Barnes in Bayfield County is seeking applicants for two **Aquatic Plant Surveyor** positions for the summer of 2005. Approx. start date would be June 6 with employment through August 26. The position would be 40/hr per week. @ \$10/hr. Individual must be highly motivated, able to operate a boat, and work flex time, Must be 18 years of age or older by June 1, 2005

**Responsibilities** include, but but may not be limited to: conducting aquatic plant field surveys of the Eau Claire Lakes and adjacent waters; working with volunteers; recording and mapping survey findings.

**Necessary Skills:** Ability to work in boats with moderate level of physical duties. Must have a valid drivers license, ability to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions, Ability to write findings of survey clearly on forms and field notebooks.

**Other advantageous skills:** familiar with maps and mapping skills; aquatic plant species identification, GPS (global positioning system) use and mapping software, boating and trailering skills, computer skills (word processing, and spreadsheets.) Persons selected will go through training of survey techniques, boat and trailering safety, GPS use, mapping techniques, and aquatic plant identification. .
