Discussed the grant from Bayfield County and perhaps plan ahead to budget and be able to apply for grant for equipment next year. Barnes does not have a grant writer right now.

Blair will get costs for storage garage at TLP from Menards with the current specs before next meeting. The town budget has allocated \$20,000 towards the garage. It may be able to be built using volunteer labor with the budget available.
