


BARNES AQUATIC INVASIVE SPECIES SUCTION PONTOON BOAT





HOW IT WORKS

• The pontoon has a suction tube that allows the diver to go down to pick the invasive plants. The diver then uses the hose to suck the plants up to the pontoon where they are drained and bagged into the garbage bags.



BAISS BOAT CREW



Two divers

One in the water while the other manages the lines and collects stray weeds from the surface



One volunteer


Drive the pontoon boat to dive site

Assist with anchoring at location


Start the motor for the suction

Refill gas in motors as needed

Put weeds collected into garbage bags



DON'T OVERFILL BAGS






- When plant material gets the to the second pipe from the top, it is time to switch out the bags
- Release the clamps and either pull the bag out or if it is too heavy, the pipe basket is removable and can be lifted up and over the bag

START THE MOTOR



- Looking down and behind the motor you will see the on/off switch
- Turn switch to on
- Pull the cord to start the engine –
 just like on a lawn mower











FILL MOTORS WITH GAS

- When the divers
 switch out it is time to
 refuel the motor for
 the suction and the
 oxygen & then do a
 final fill at the end of
 your shift
- Depress the green button to release the fuel when pouring
